DRIVER INSTRUCTION

1. Vehicle Safety: As a driver of a car transporting students, you are responsible for providing a safe vehicle in excellent condition and repair, including the following:
 - Minimum tread on tires (not bald or worn)
 - Working horn, lights, turn signals, mirrors
 - Normal operating engine
 - Normal mechanical systems, including suspension, steering and brakes
 - Seat belts for all passengers
 - Appropriate spare tire, highway flares
 - Normal interior and exterior
 2. The volunteer driver has met all the legal requirements for possessing a driver's license; has an excellent driving record; and is 21 years of age or older (preferably a parent of one of the students). Under special circumstances, if students are required to go to another school site or other location during their scheduled day as a portion of their curricular program and there is not any other mode of transportation students may volunteer to drive themselves, and others, in their own vehicles. Student drivers and their passengers are required to submit a signed parental permission form to drive or be a passenger in a student driven vehicle. **This special circumstances provision does not apply to field trips.** Students shall **not** drive on any school or class field trips. The teacher of the class must provide a properly signed and executed School Driver certification form to the principal of the school before the student is allowed to drive. An explanation of description of the activity shall be sent with the forms to the site Administrator. Special circumstance trips may not exceed a 30-mile radius of the District.
 3. The car being driven has an operational seat belt for each person being transported. The driver certifies that all passengers will be restrained using the appropriate passenger restraint systems (child car seat, booster seat, and /or safety belts). Furthermore, children age 12 (twelve) and under shall not ride in the front passenger seat of any vehicle equipped with a front seat airbag.
 4. The driver accepts the added responsibility that comes with carrying students, and therefore is more conscious of all driving rules and regulations set forth by the State of California. The California Supreme Court has eliminated the protection of the former California Guest Law.
 5. The driver understands that if an accident occurs, the driver's insurance coverage shall bear primary responsibility for any losses or claims for damages.
 6. In case of emergency, Driver agrees to keep all passengers together and call 911, the appropriate school, and the district office.
- *Note: When driving a district vehicle, district insurance is primary. All district vehicles are required to have sufficient operational seatbelts for each passenger and are kept in good repair. Please notify transportation department immediately of any problems experienced with driving a district vehicle.*
